

ASSISTED LIVING AND MEMORY CARE

Licensed Adult Foster Care, based on a culture of person centered care in a dementia friendly community.

In addition to the services listed on the reverse side, the following services and amenities are included:

- Home cooked made to order breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily
- Assistance and observation with medications by staff with Licensed oversight
- Assistance with personal hygiene, grooming, dressing and bathing
- Reminders and cueing for memory loss and confusion
- Stand by assistance with mobility or wheelchair transportation to activities and meals
- Daily housekeeping services
- Laundering machine washable clothing and linens (max 1 load/day, \$8.00 each additional load)
- Room furnishings (Bed and dresser if necessary)
- Wearable call pendants
- Walk-in shower
- Hydrotherapy tub available

ASSISTED LIVING

Residents who require one-person to assist them with activities of daily living (ADL's) and assistance with transfers can be accommodated at this level. Residents experiencing the early stages of dementia, memory loss or confusion may also be accommodated in Assisted Living.

Care team to Resident Ratio 1: 10

Studio Apartment (400 sq. ft.) \$5,217/month

Luxury Apartment (620 sq. ft.) \$6,364/month

Second Occupant in Apartment \$1,200/month

This fee is in addition to the monthly rental rate of a studio or luxury apartment and includes medication assistance and meals.

MEMORY CARE

Residents who require up to a two-person assist with activities of daily living (ADL's) and assistance with transfers can be accommodated at this level. Residents experiencing the early stages of dementia, memory loss or confusion may also be accommodated in Assisted Living. Care Team is available to assist with those who may need help dining. Residents who are experiencing more advanced stages of dementia, memory loss and confusion can benefit from the care provided at this level.

Care Team to Resident Ration 1: 5

Studio Apartment (400sq ft.) \$7,762/month

Second Occupant in Apartment \$2,000/month

This fee is in addition to the monthly rental rate of a studio or luxury apartment and includes medication assistance and meals.

RETREAT / VACATION RENTALS

If applicant meets criteria for residency and an apartment is available, furnishing included, fee is a minimum of the weekly rate. Includes three meals a day, housekeeping and laundry services.
